



BUILDING INSPECTION & PLAN REVIEWER PAY

- Inspection and review staff shall maintain at a minimum one recognized certification for employment.
- Not including the required certification, six (6) additional recognized certifications will be compensated at a rate of:

\$25 per month and limited to a maximum of \$150 per month

BUILDING INSPECTOR: RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATIONS:

Certifications allowed to meet the minimum job requirement of one (1) certification within six (6) months of employment. Any additional certifications obtained in this category are considered voluntary and eligible for certification pay.

CODE ENFORCEMENT, ANIMAL CONTROL AND NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES PAY

- Code Enforcement and Animal Control staff shall maintain at a minimum one recognized certification for employment.
- Not including the required certification, six (6) additional recognized certifications will be compensated at a rate of:
\$25 per month and limited to a maximum of \$150 per month

Code Enforcement Officer and Code Enforcement Supervisor Certification Pay

Basic Code Enforcement Certification is to be obtained to meet the minimum job requirements within one (1) year of employment for Code Enforcement Officer. Basic Code Enforcement Officer, Intermediate Code Enforcement Certification and International Property Maintenance Code Inspector Certification are required to meet the minimum job requirements for Code Enforcement Supervisor. Any additional certifications obtained in this category are considered voluntary and eligible for certification pay.

Animal Control Officer, Animal Control Supervisor Pay

Basic Animal Control Officer Certification and Euthanasia Technician Certification are required within four (4) months of employment to meet the minimum job requirements for Animal Control Officers. The Animal Control Supervisor is required to have the Basic Animal Control Officer Certification and Euthanasia Technician within four (4) months of employment, and Basic Code Enforcement Officer Certification within one (1) year of employment. Any additional certifications obtained in this category are considered voluntary and eligible for certification pay.
