NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS
PY 2019 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN
SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT PROPOSED BUDGET**

In accordance with the federal regulations governing the use of CDBG funds and the Citizen Participation Plan outlined in the City’s 2015-19 Consolidated Plan, the City of Frisco proposes Substantial Amendment No. 5 to the PY 2015-19 Consolidated Action Plan and specifically the PY 2019 Annual Action Plan. The substantial change entails the reallocation of CDBG-CV1 funding to Public Service Projects, allocation of CDBG-CV3 funding in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, and reallocation of Housing Rehabilitation funding to Frisco Housing Authority projects to improve public housing in the City of Frisco.

On January 17, 2021, the City of Frisco published the First Notice of Funding Availability for CDBG-CV3 Funds. On February 14, 2021, the City of Frisco published the Second Notice of Funding Availability of Funding including reallocation opportunities for CDBG-CV1 and allocation opportunities of CDBG-CV3 Funds.

The City of Frisco is seeking public comment on the utilization of grant funds in the amount of \$327,936 for the 2015-19 Consolidated Plan and PY 2019 Annual Action Plan. The following proposed budget includes funding that will be presented at a meeting of the City Council on Wednesday, April 6, 2021, at 6:30 PM. Nonprofit organizations currently working with the City who are interested in funding, please contact the Community Development Division to indicate your interest in carrying out an emergency short-term rental/mortgage/utility assistance program or submit a proposal and budget for proposed use of funds for the dates of May 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022.

A final public hearing will be held on April 14, 2021, at 6:30 PM at a meeting of the Social Services and Housing Board. The purpose of the public hearings is to receive comments on the City’s proposed use of the CARES Act Relief fund and reallocation of Housing Rehabilitation funding to Frisco Housing Authority improvement project. The final budget will be made available for public review and comment from March 22 through April 20, 2021. Final adoption is scheduled for April 20, 2021.
