The residents of Creekside at Stonebriar work closely with their management company and landscaper to ensure that the landscaping is both beautiful and serene. But don't let the beauty fool you, given their unique micro environment, Creekside's landscaping is also strategic to help manage water, and money.

A PARTNERSHIP OF FORM & FUNCTION

Because Stonebriar Creek runs through the HOA, it is especially important to this HOA to plant native and adaptive plants throughout the neighborhood. Native and adaptive plants will send their roots down deep, allowing them to absorb more water than non-native plants. This helps to collect rainfall as it heads for the creek; mitigating runoff and better filtering that water before it reaches the creek, keeping the overall ecosystem of Stonebriar Creek healthy, and their environmental impact low.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

Creekside at Stonebriar developed their common areas into lovely vignettes, populated by native and adaptive plants, allowing Creekside to enjoy beautiful landscaping while managing and saving water and saving money. Several residents take personal responsibility for the creation of these areas that the whole community enjoys.
