

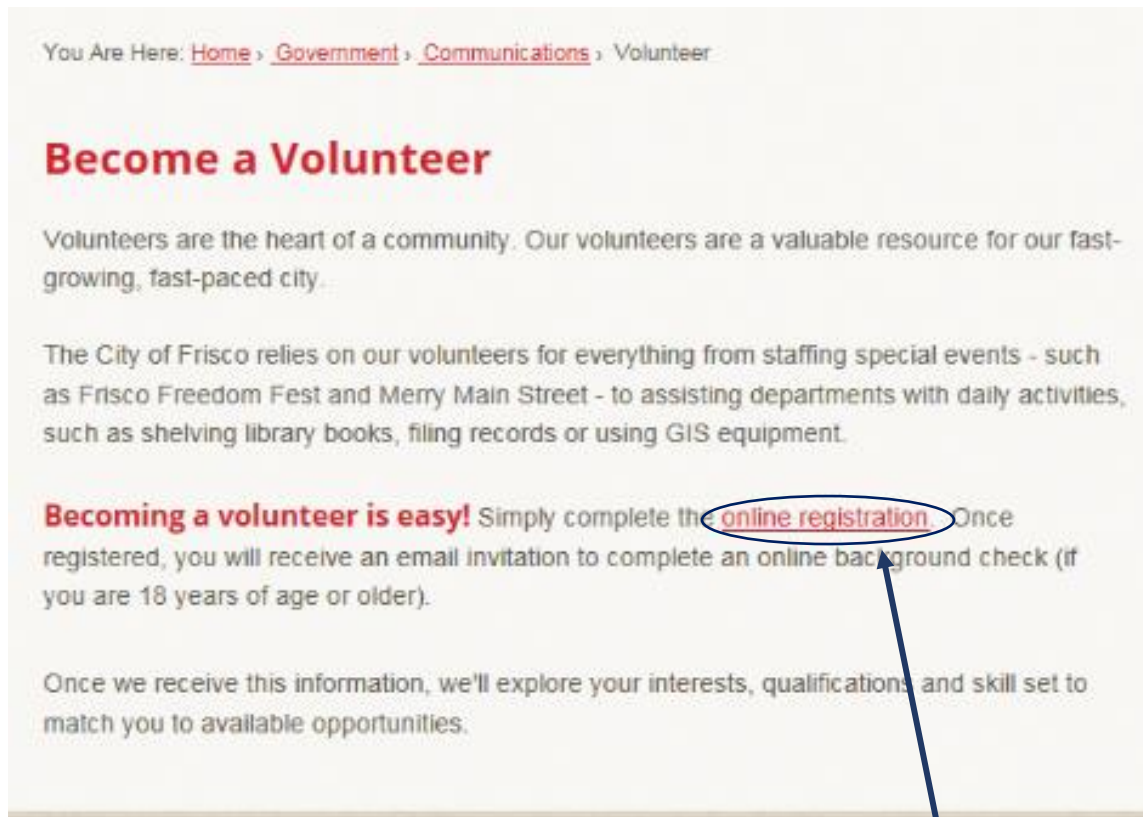


Online Registration for Volunteers

Thank you for Volunteering with the City of Frisco, WaterWise Team! The City tracks volunteer hours for all departments. In order for us to enter the volunteer hour information, the volunteer must be registered in the City's online database. Please complete the required online registration using the instructions below.

Begin your registration process at: friscotexas.gov/volunteer

The page should look like this:



All volunteers need to fill complete online registration.

Volunteers 18 years old & up must pass a background check in order to participate.

Anyone wishing to volunteer who is under age 13 must be accompanied by a chaperone
