Subject: Consider and Act Upon Award of Competitive Sealed Proposal #1805-080 Parkwood Pavement Improvements to KT Contracting, LLC, and Approval Authorizing the City Manager to Execute an Agreement for these Services

Action Requested: City Council award of Competitive Sealed Proposal #1805-080 Parkwood Pavement Improvements to KT Contracting, LLC, and approval authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement for these services in the amount of \$86,588.

Background Information: Purchasing solicited Competitive Sealed Proposal ("CSP") #1805-080 Parkwood Pavement Improvements and received proposals on June 12, 2018 from Accelerated Critical Path, Advanced Paving, FNH Construction and KT Contracting. Proposals were evaluated based on criteria stated in the CSP, and staff is recommending award to KT Contracting as the highest ranked proposer. This project includes pavement repairs for two sections of Parkwood Boulevard, just north of Wade Boulevard. A timeframe of fifteen (15) days is allotted for the completion of this project, at a total cost of \$86,588.
