



# Service Move Guide

## **\*\* NOTICE \*\***

There will be a **reschedule fee of \$100** if Public Works cannot complete the service move during the initial appointment, due to not following the directions on this form.

**\*\* The City of Frisco does not allow water meters to be set in concrete (driveways or sidewalks). \*\***

### **Plumber or Builder Responsibilities**

1. Have the trench pre-dug before City staff arrives.
2. Plumber will move the service once the city arrives on the job site.
3. Plumber will provide the like size Compression Couplings.
4. Plumber will supply a NEW angle stop for all service moves. Angles stops will not be reused. **(new parts only)**
5. No 90 FITTINGS or SWEAT FITTINGS will be accepted on the City side of service. **(compression fittings only)**
6. Type K Copper or Blue Endotrace Poly only.
7. Customers MUST be notified by the HOME BUILDER that water will be shut off. **(24 hour minimum)**
8. Proper bedding for copper must be supplied by the HOME BUILDER. **(sand)**

### **\*\* City of Frisco Responsibilities \*\***

**Turn the water OFF for the service move. Turn water ON when the plumber is finished. FINAL inspection must be completed prior to plumber backfill.**
