**Fire hydrant meter rentals take place by APPOINTMENT ONLY,
Monday - Thursday, 8:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.
Arrival 15 minutes after your scheduled time will be considered a "No Show"
and the appointment will need to be rescheduled.**

All contractors **must be registered** to work in the City of Frisco and be in good standing with Utility Billing.

Fire Hydrant Meter Applications are available at the Public Works facility. When completing a Fire Hydrant Meter Application the application **MUST** include the following:

- Tax ID number
- Job site address
- Job site contract

**** If working on a city project, the bid number must also be on the application. ****

This temporary connection to the water system is a potential source of contamination. The contractor or individual will be responsible for the installation and testing of a Reduced Pressure Zone (RPZ) device at the time of connection. The meter cannot be used until the RPZ has been tested, and is proven to be in good working order. The device must be tested each time it is moved or annually from that date forward.

If the connection is anticipated to be used for human consumption, you must use one of the City of Frisco approved lead free RPZ devices listed below:

- 2" Lead Free - Watts LF2009
- 2" Lead Free - Wilkins Zurn 375LFT
- 2" Lead Free - Wilkins Zurn 975XL2

You must bring the device with you to pick up the meter.

Fees must be paid at the time of application. Acceptable forms of payment include: cash, check, Mastercard, American Express and Discover. **All credit cards will be charged a 2% processing fee.** Visa credit cards ARE NOT ACCEPTED. Only Visa debit is acceptable.

**** All readings must be emailed or called into Public Works between the 1st and 10th of every month.****

If the 10th is on a weekend, then the meter reading is due on Friday by close of business. Any reading received after the 10th will be assessed a **\$100 'no read' fee** on their utility bill.
