The Industrial & Hazardous Waste (I&HW) Permits Section of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) received your letter, prepared by Golder Associates Inc. on behalf of Exide Technologies, dated October 16, 2019. The letter requests a 21-day extension for the submittal of your response to the technical NOD No. 2 letter for the above-referenced application.

The technical NOD letter, dated October 2, 2019, required a response due to this office by November 1, 2019. We understand that you and your company are working to address the technical NOD and this additional time is required to fully address these items. Your letter contained sufficient information to justify the requested extension.

The I&HW Permits Section hereby extends the due date for the submittal of the NOD response by 21-days. Your response is now due to the I&HW Permits Section by November 22, 2019.

If a satisfactory response to each of the noted deficiencies is not received by November 22, 2019, the application may be returned, denied, and/or sent to Enforcement. Additionally, please note that future extension requests are not guaranteed and may not be granted.
