RULES OF THE ROAD

When Encountering an Emergency Vehicle

In Regular Traffic

- Observe all road rules
- Slow down
- Choose your lane based on the signs and pavement markings
- Yield for pedestrians in crosswalks
- Yield to traffic in **all** lanes on your left before entering
- Don't change lanes until you have exited the roundabout

Before entering the roundabout, move to the right so emergency vehicles can pass.

Yield to pedestrians and bicyclists using crosswalks.

Do not enter a roundabout when an emergency vehicle is approaching from another direction.

Yield to **all** traffic coming from the left.

Circulating traffic has the right-of-way. Never stop within a roundabout. Continue to your exit.

If you're already in the roundabout, **do not stop** because the emergency vehicle may not be able to pass.

The driver in the roundabout can either exit or continue circulating. Entering vehicles must yield to **all** traffic coming from the left.

After you exit the roundabout, move to the right and stop so emergency vehicles can pass.
