TOWN & COUNTRY BOULEVARD

The design plans for Town & Country Boulevard are complete and ready for advertisement for bids. We are working toward acquisition of the last property needed for the project. Once acquired, we will move forward with the bidding process. We expect to begin construction in October 2020.

The existing lanes of Town & Country Boulevard, from Spring Creek Parkway to Legacy Drive, will be reconstructed and widened from a two lane undivided roadway to a four lane divided roadway.

LEGACY DRIVE

Design plans are expected according to the following schedule:

60% Completion – July 2020

90% Completion – September 2020

Award the Construction Contract – December 2020

Begin Construction – January 2021

The staff of several Frisco departments have completed review of the project's preliminary (60%) design plans.
