



NAT'L WALK 'N ROLL TO SCHOOL DAY

Plan a Walk 'N Roll Event 7 Steps in 7 Days

1. Ask the school's principal to approve your event.
2. Register your event at www.WalkBikeToSchool.org and be counted among millions of participants nationwide.
3. Invite students and parents to participate. If the school has an e-newsletter or listserv, use those resources to announce your event.
4. Visit www.FriscoTexas.gov/SchoolZoneSafety for a toolkit with promotional materials that can easily be printed on a home computer.
5. On the day before your event, make a reminder announcement on the school's intercom system encouraging students to walk & roll to school the next day.
6. Create posters or a banner that will greet students when they arrive at school on the event day. "It's Walk 'n Roll To School Day" or "It's cool to walk 'n roll to school!" signs can be downloaded at www.FriscoTexas.gov/schoolZoneSafety
7. Ask students to list the Top 10 ways they got their parents and family to bike to school with them. Save the students' lists to get ideas for next year's event.
