



PROGRESS IN MOTION

What needs to be attached when applying for a Right of Way Permit for antenna and radio modification on a city own tower or pole.

- If you are troubleshooting any existing Equipment on a Tower, i.e. Antenna, Radio, Coaxial Cable, or Brackets You are required to submit a signed letter stating if any existing Equipment is Replaced it will be like- for- like. This includes Reorientation of Antennas. If anything is changed that is not like- for- like, this will trigger a potential new structural review.
- If you are adding new or upgrading existing equipment a sealed detail drawing all points of connection for new and existing, a structural letter from the tank manufacture is required. This keeps all Equipment loads, and Penetrations on file with Tank Manufacture for the lifecycle of Tank - on Record. (CHICAGO BRIDGE & IRON COMPANY or LANDMARK)
- If using third Parties for any scope of work related to Tower, Sub-Contractor's must be listed on the R.O.W. permit. Scaffolding Contractor is a prime example. This will avoid stop work inconvenience.
- R.O.W Permit must be onsite for access and available upon request. Paper copy is required, or electronic copy is acceptable for verification.
