
Dear George :

Below are Exide's responses to your verbal requests:

- Exide will voluntarily withdraw Exide Technologies' application for a permit modification to allow an increase in production at its lead recycling facility located in Frisco, Texas.
- Exide will work with TCEQ to locate monitors as recommended by TCEQ for the upcoming lead NAAQS standard of $0.15 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$.
- Exide is willing to discuss community impact programs and costs with the City and in principle, will support initiatives in this area.
- Exide will conduct the delineation studies at the Stewart Creek Waste Water Treatment Plant site.
- Exide will install additional controls as necessary and appropriate to attain compliance with the upcoming lead NAAQS standard of $0.15 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$.

During its operation of the facility, Exide has worked to continuously improve its environmental and safety controls and has been making the necessary investments to ensure compliance with legal standards. Ambient lead in air monitoring results from around the Exide Frisco facility have been lower than the previous NAAQS standard for lead of $1.5 \mu\text{g}/\text{m}^3$ for over a decade. As always, we are committed to maintaining a positive relationship with The City of Frisco.
