## DEVELOPMENT SERVICES CERTIFICATION PAY

### BUILDING INSPECTION & PLAN REVIEWER PAY

- Inspection and review staff shall maintain at a minimum one recognized certification for employment.
- Not including the required certification, six (6) additional recognized certifications will be compensated at a rate of:

**\$25 per month and limited to a maximum of \$150 per month**

#### **BUILDING INSPECTOR & REHABILITATION SPECIALIST: RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATIONS:**

*Certifications allowed to meet the minimum job requirement of one (1) certification within six (6) months of employment. Any additional certifications obtained in this category are considered voluntary and eligible for certification pay.*

## HEALTH & FOOD SAFETY PAY

- Inspection Specialists shall maintain at a minimum one licensure and 2 certifications.
- Inspectors shall maintain a minimum 3 certifications.
- Not including the required licensure or certifications, six (6) additional recognized licenses and certifications will be compensated at a rate of:

**\$25 per month and limited to a maximum of \$150 per month**

### HEALTH SPECIALIST: RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATIONS:

*Licenses or Certifications allowed to meet the minimum job requirement of one (1) License within six (6) months of employment. Any additional certifications obtained in this category are considered voluntary and eligible for certification pay.*

## CODE ENFORCEMENT PAY

- Code Enforcement staff shall maintain at a minimum one recognized certification for employment.
- Not including the required certification, six (6) additional recognized certifications will be compensated at a rate of:

**\$25 per month and limited to a maximum of \$150 per month**

### **CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND CODE ENFORCEMENT SUPERVISOR: RECOGNIZED CERTIFICATIONS:**

*Basic Code Enforcement Certification is to be obtained to meet the minimum job requirements within one (1) year of employment for Code Enforcement Officer. Basic Code Enforcement Officer, Intermediate Code Enforcement Certification and International Property Maintenance Code Inspector Certification are required to meet the minimum job requirements for Code Enforcement Supervisor. Any additional certifications obtained in this category are considered voluntary and eligible for certification pay.*
