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

The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has reviewed the September 2, 2016 report entitled "Quarterly Status Report", submitted on your behalf. The report includes a 180-day extension request to submit a revised Affected Property Assessment Report (APAR) and Response Action Completion Report (RACR). The extension is needed in order to plan and complete the proposed removal of municipal solid waste (MSW) from the historic MSW disposal trench. The results of the MSW removal will be incorporated into a revised APAR and RACR. The TCEQ approves the extension request and the new due date for document submittal is March 4, 2017.
